Getting to U of T by public transit (see <http://www.ttc.ca/>)

Subway

There are two subway stations near the St. George campus:

- St. George (at Bloor Street and St. George Street)
- Spadina (at Bloor Street and Spadina Road) (This is closest station to the Holiday Inn)

Streetcar

There are two streetcar routes that pass by campus:

- The [510 Spadina streetcar](#) runs along Spadina Avenue from Spadina subway station, along the western edge of the campus.
- The [506 Carleton streetcar](#) runs along College Street, along the southern part of the campus. You can catch the 506 from College station and Queen's Park station on the north-south Yonge-University-Spadina line.

Transit fares

An adult single fare on the TTC is \$3.00 cash. Street cars require exact change or tokens. Tokens are sold at subway stations at \$2.70 each when you buy 3 or more at a time.

Getting to U of T by car

Driving directions

Our [St. George campus](#) is located in downtown Toronto. It spans several city blocks, stretching approximately north from College Street, east from Spadina Avenue, south from Bloor Street and west from Bay Street. Call [TripInfo](#) to get information about scheduled Toronto road closures. Be aware that traffic in downtown Toronto can be quite congested, particularly during “rush hour” – about 8-9 AM and 4-6 PM. Due the upcoming PanAm Games, some roads on campus may be closed.

The campus is accessible via the Gardiner Expressway and the Don Valley Parkway, which connect Toronto with Ontario's 400-series highways.

- If you are travelling eastbound on the Gardiner Expressway, you can choose any one of three exit ramps located at Spadina Avenue, York Street and Bay Street.
- If you are travelling southbound on the Don Valley Parkway, take the Bloor/Bayview exit ramp (use the Bloor Street lane).
- The University of Toronto has a number of parking lots (see <http://map.utoronto.ca/utsg/s?q=parking>). The underground parking lot at 107 St George Garage (Rotman/Innis parking lot) is probably the best location. Rates are \$20/day. Information about public parking lots can be found at <http://parking.greenp.com/> or check out <http://toronto.bestparking.com/>.

Arriving by air

If you are arriving by plane, you can take a car, a taxi, or public transit from [Pearson International Airport](#) or the [Toronto Island Airport](#) to downtown Toronto.

- 1) Taxi from Pearson International Airport. **approximate cost: \$50 one way**
- 2) If you are taking the brand new (opens on June 6!) Union Pearson Express from Pearson International Airport, you can pre-purchase your ticket on their website, <https://www.upexpress.com/Home/index>. The train will take you to Union Station. From here, you can take the subway to St George Station. **approximate cost: \$27.50 one way**
- 3) If you are taking public transit from Pearson International Airport, you can take the **192 Airport Rocket** — this bus takes you to Kipling subway station. From Kipling, take the subway eastbound to **St. George subway station**. **approximate cost: \$3.00 one way.**

If you are flying [Porter Airlines](#) and decide to take public transit from the Toronto Island Airport:

- Catch the Porter shuttle, which will drop you off at to the north-east corner of Front Street and York Street.
- Cross to the south side of Front Street and enter Union subway station.
- Take the University-Spadina line subway northbound to St. George subway station.
